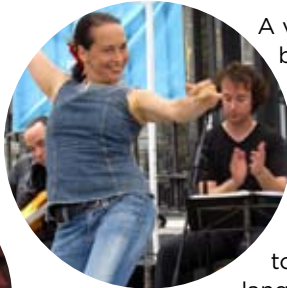


JULY 15 ART BARON & FRIENDS

JULY 22 LATIN UP – RAY SANTIAGO

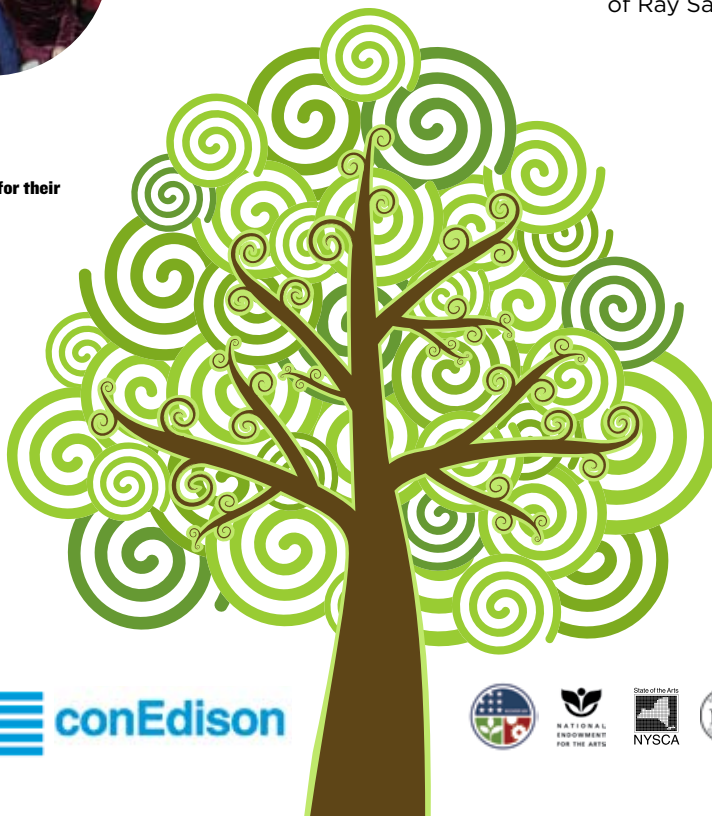
This New York Latin dance and jam band features the hard-driving piano playing and earthy direction of Ray Santiago.
