#### HERITAGE O.P. ENSEMBLE

Heritage Organic Percussion is comprised of four master drummers who have traveled the world playing and performing. At the core of their inspiration is the drum, which can cause all hearts to beat as one. Immersed and versed in drum traditions of West Africa, the Caribbean and the Americas, they present an exciting and groove-intense performance that gets audiences dancing. Their instruments include djembe, surdo, mbira, talking drum, shekere and voice.



### JULY 21

#### STRINGBEANS LATIN BRAZILIAN JAZZ

This jazz septet, founded by Annette A. Aguilar, began playing in New York City's East Village and Lower East Side in 1992. Since then, they have been selected as Latin Jazz Ambassadors by the U.S. State Department, the Kennedy Center and Jazz at Lincoln Center. The group has toured South Africa, Rwanda, Ethiopia, Tanzania and Madagascar (where they performed for the President), sharing their knowledge of music from the Americas and the Caribbean.

#### THE CLAIRE DALY QUARTET

The Claire Daly Quartet, led by NYC baritone saxophonist Claire Daly, is a remarkable combination of worldly musicians who focus their attention on the music and spirit of electric jazz musician Rahsaan Roland Kirk.
